Outside buildings, plastic pipes drain large rainwater volumes from flat roof tops quickly and efficiently. Rain gutters and downpipes help by harvesting rainwater and storing it to be re-used as grey household water and for irrigation during drought periods.

The Plastic Pavilion will be located on **Gammel Strand** in Copenhagen, Denmark from **19 June** to **14 July 2023** and TEPPFA invites you all to visit it and learn about the unlimited possibilities of plastic in construction and innovation.
