HOUSTON TO HOST 2027 PLASTIC PIPES CONFERENCE

Organizers of the 23rd Plastic Pipes Conference (PPXXIII) have announced the Woodlands Waterway Marriott Hotel & Convention Center in Houston, TX, USA as the location of their next Conference and Exhibition event to be hosted through 27-29 September 2027.
